ORDER:

Vide the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> above (6) Government Pleaders have been appointed in addition to the Government Pleaders appointed vide G.O first read above in view of the exigency. Vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> above (31) Assistant Government Pleaders have been appointed to assist the Government Pleaders in the Hon'ble High Court in addition to the Assistant Government Pleaders appointed vide the G.O. second read above. **Instructions to the Government Pleaders / Asst. Government Pleaders:**

1) In respect of matters or cases assigned to the Advocate General, concerned Government Pleaders/ Asst. Government Pleaders are responsible in all respects, namely obtaining instructions, filing counter affidavits, pursuing court proceedings and communicating with the concerned Department/Officers. In addition to the above, any case entrusted to the Govt. Pleader / Asst. Govt. Pleader take responsibility to conduct the case or appearance, etc.



2) It is further informed, that all the matters either in respect of financial implications, valuable property, public interest are to be informed to the Advocate General on the same day along with one set of papers.

3) In any case, where the Hon'ble Governor, Chairman of the Legislative Council, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Ministers and Chief Secretary are made parties either in the official/personal capacity, cases of constitutional validity, the said cases may be informed to the Advocate General. In the absence of the Advocate General, the same may be informed to the Addl. Advocate General are also to be communicated to the respective Offices/Officers concerned immediately.

4) a. Government Pleaders/Asst. Government Pleaders shall function under the general superintendence and control of the Learned Advocate-General and shall perform such duties and functions as assigned to them by the learned Advocate-General from time to time.

b. Government Pleaders/ Asst. Government Pleaders shall not appear or give any advice against the interest of the Government or any State Public Sector undertaking or Company.

c. Government Pleader/ Asst. Government Pleaders shall be wholly responsible for ensuring that all cases entrusted to them are properly prepared and represented in Courts.

5) The Asst. Government Pleaders shall function under the guidance under the Government Pleader to whom they are attached and the Government Pleaders and Asst. Government Pleaders shall function under the overall supervision on the control of the Advocate General.

6) The Asst. Government Pleaders shall attend to such duties and functions as are entrusted by the Government Pleader to whom they are attached. They shall regularly attend the office of the concerned Government Pleader. It will be their primary duty to prepare draft counters in Writ Petitions and other matters and have them finalized by the Government Pleader.

7) The appointment of Government Pleaders /Asst. Government Pleaders may be terminated by the Government after giving one month's notice or payment of one month's emoluments. It will be open to the Government Pleaders/Assistant Government Pleaders to resign after giving one month's notice.

8) The Government Pleaders/Asst. Government Pleaders are expected to be always available at Hyderabad and they shall not leave the headquarters without prior permission of the Advocate-General and without making adequate alternative arrangements.

9) The Government Pleaders/Asst. Government Pleaders should furnish a report to the Advocate-General every month of the cases disposed of, the counters filed/ yet to be filed, new cases filed and ancillary information.



10) The Government Pleaders/Asst. Government Pleaders are presently holding the post of Standing Counsel or any other Law Officer under Government Orders, they should resign before they assume charge as Government Pleaders/Asst. Government Pleaders.

11) The Government Pleaders/ Asst. Government Pleaders are required to mark their attendance through the biometric attendance system daily.
